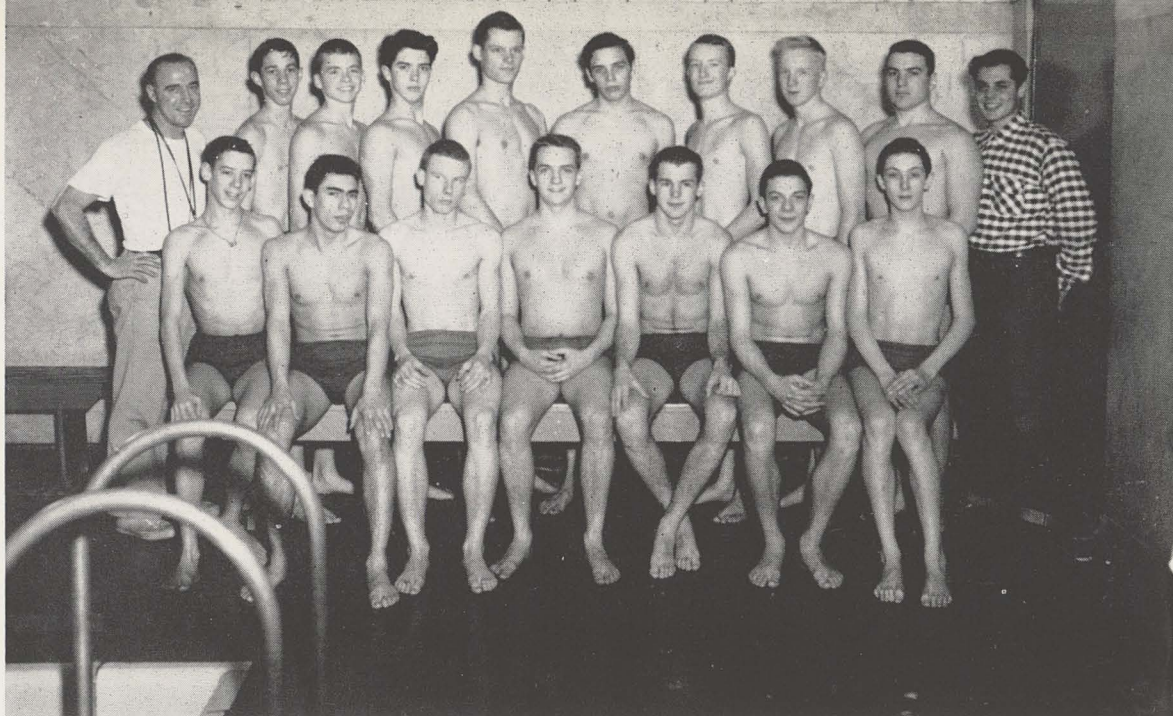

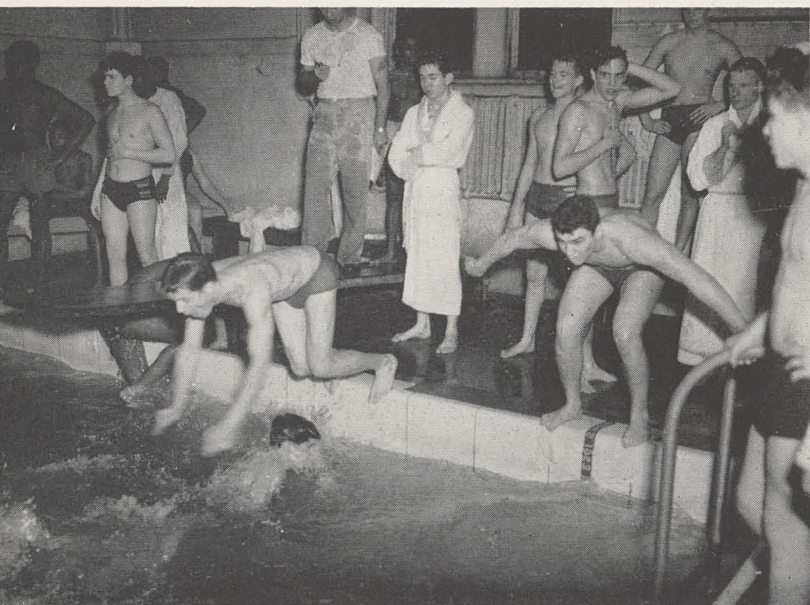


HUGHES MERMEN WIN SUPERIORITY
