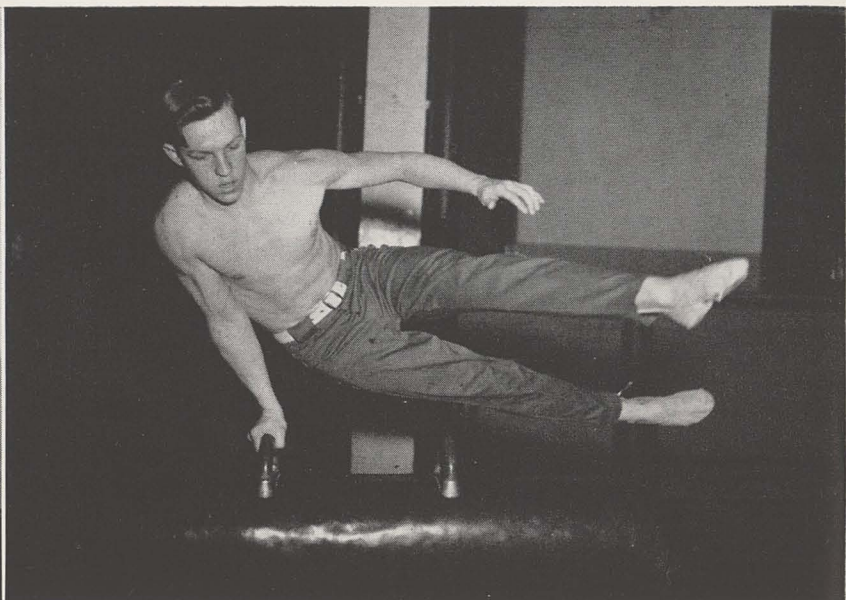


Don Burdsall shows good form on rings
