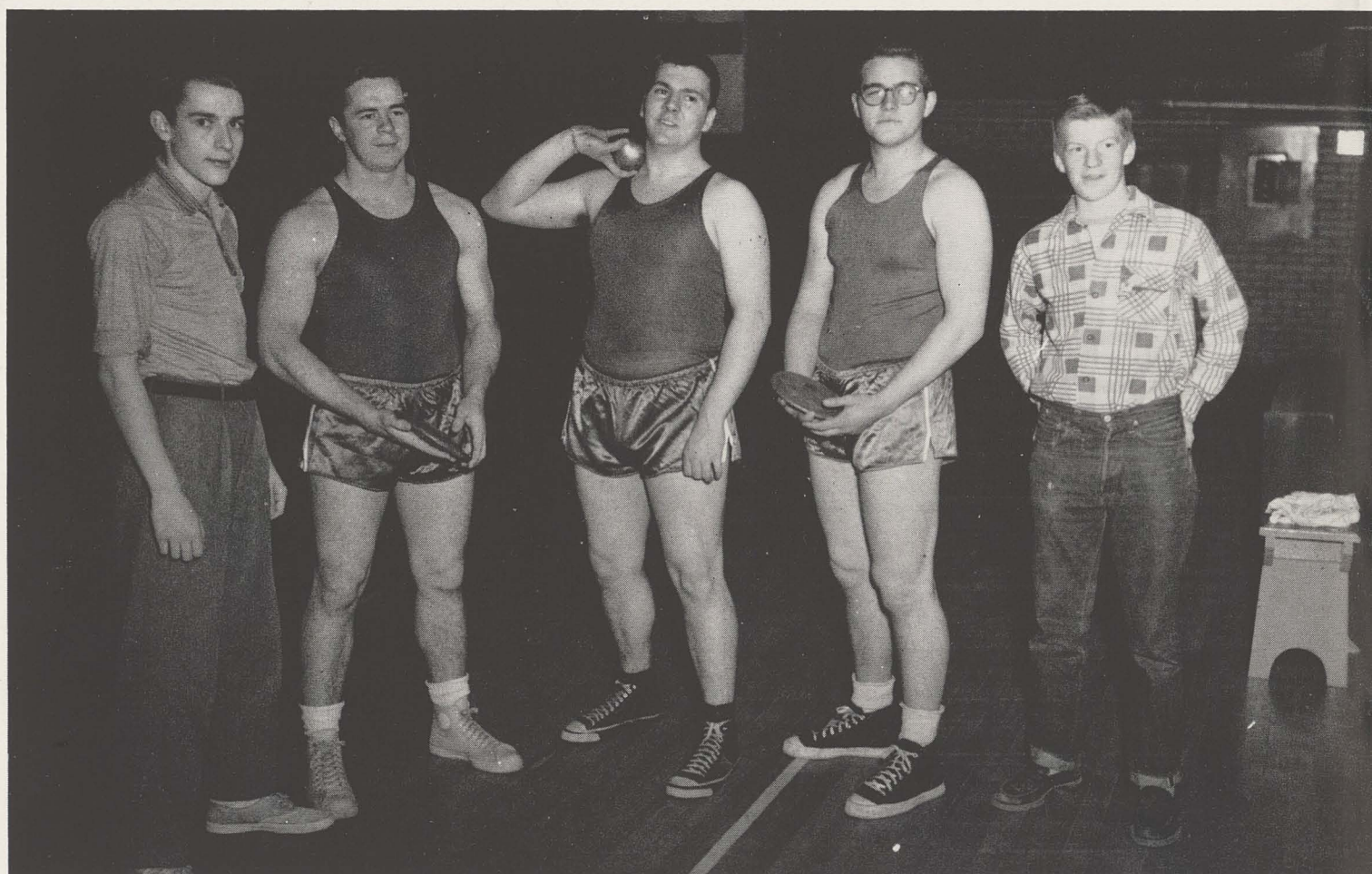


CINDERMEN TAKE SECOND CONSECUTIVE CROWN
