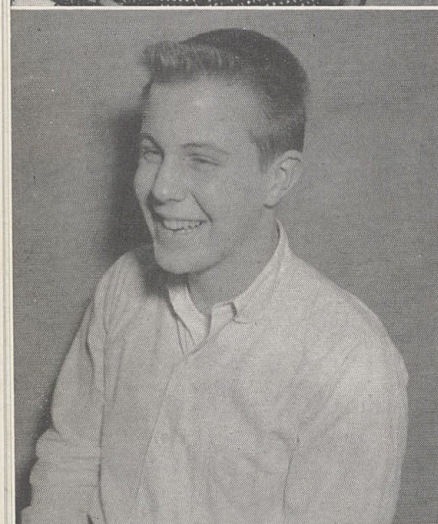

The athletic teams at Hughes are not the only ones who bring home honors. Students have a right to be proud of their weekly newspaper, the *Gargoyle*, a paper that's proud of meeting its deadline. For the past two years the *Gargoyle* has received the top ranking as Medalist Class in the Scholastic Press Association of Columbia University contest. The Columbia Medalist award is presented to those papers whose overall makeup and publication procedure rank them as an outstanding student activity. The *Gargoyle* was awarded Medalist, a top award in a class of 1400 other student publications. For the first time in 30 years the *Gargoyle* received the exclusive All-Columbian award for creative writing.

Reporters from the *Gargoyle* have been hired as correspondents for "Dateline," a teenage column in *Good Housekeeping*, for which they received a regular correspondent's salary.

Seventeen magazine honored the *Gargoyle* by publishing a full-length article, complete with pictures of staff members. This article was featured in "It's All Yours," a section of the magazine dedicated to the creative talents of young people. The prize-winning *Gargoyle* is under the direction of Miss Hazel L. Koppenhoefer, staff adviser, and Miss Gladys J. Kloak, financial adviser.
