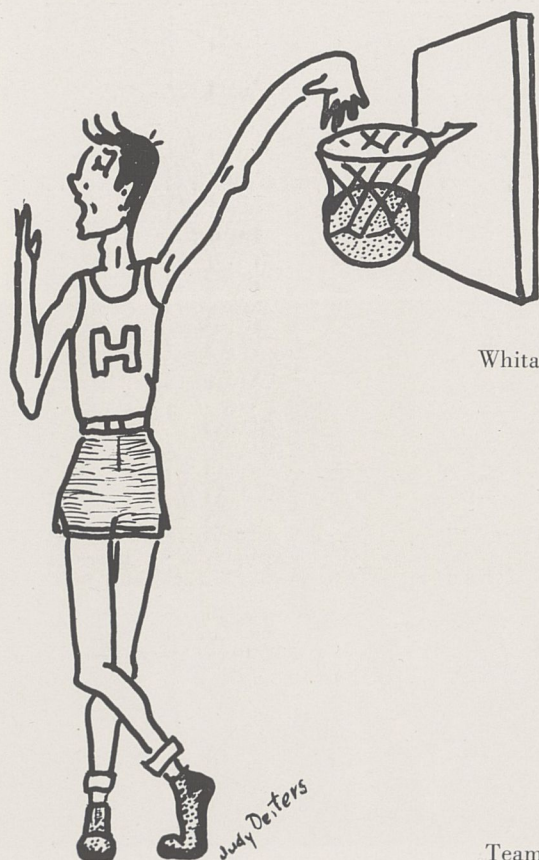


Coach Grimes plans strategy with Co-Captains Whitaker and Edwards.
