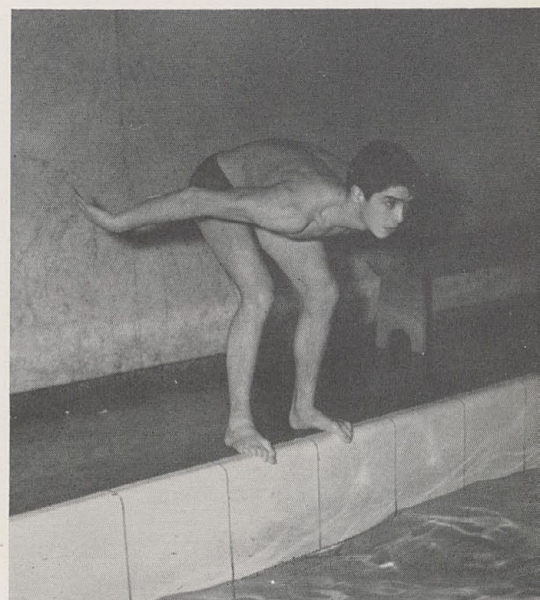


Hughes Aquamen prepare to jump

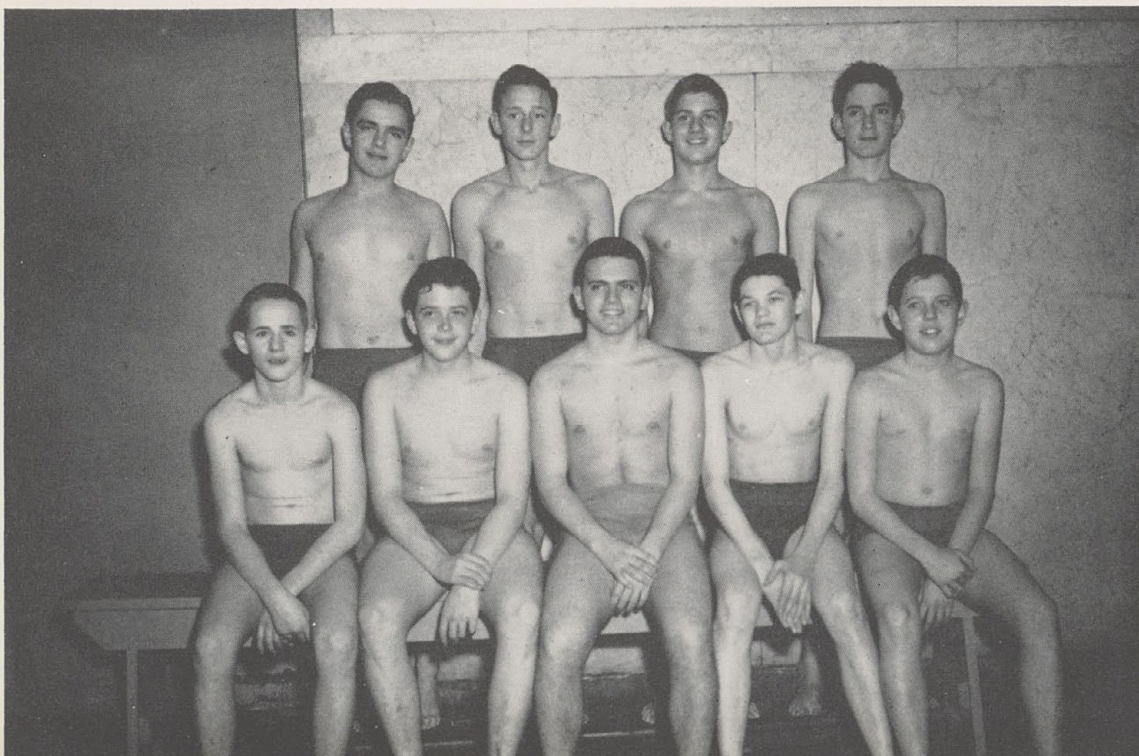
style, 50-yd. free-style, and 150-yd. individual. The 150-yd. medley took fourth place while the 200-yd. senior relay placed third.
