



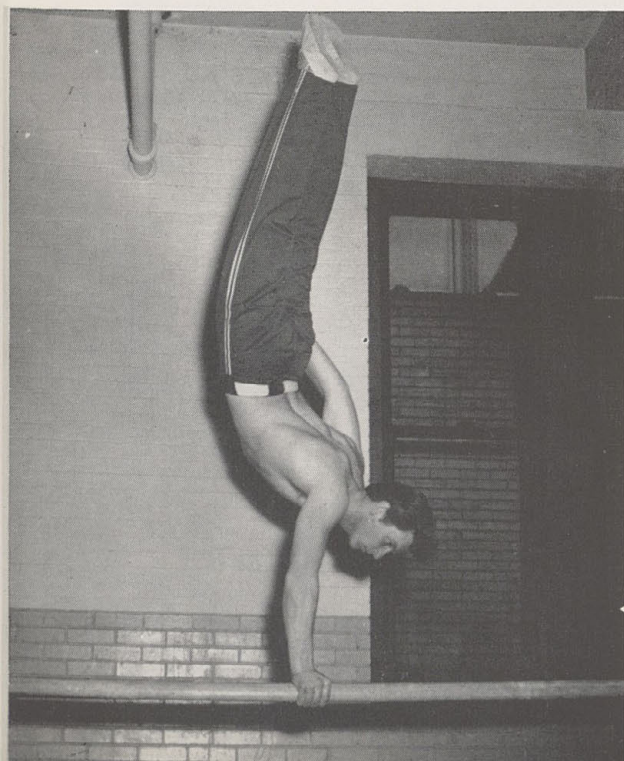
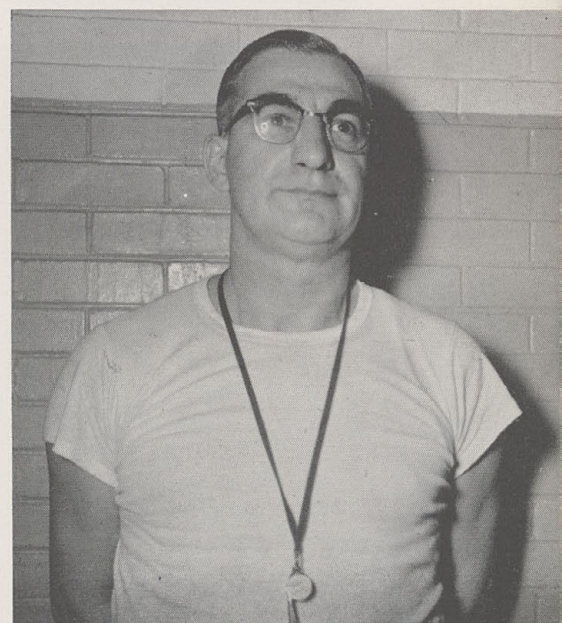
The "little matmen," following in the footsteps of their elder brothers, copped second in P.H.S.L.
