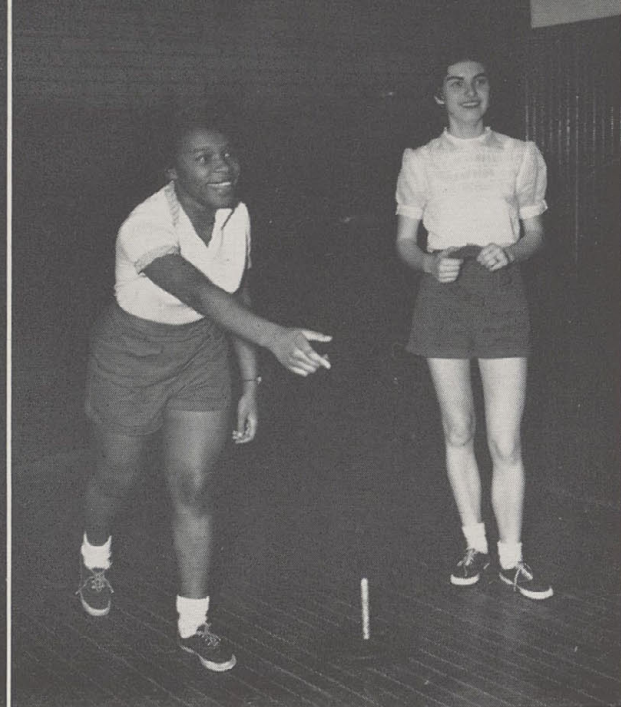




Roz Korn and Janice Freckman have a wild game of table tennis.
