

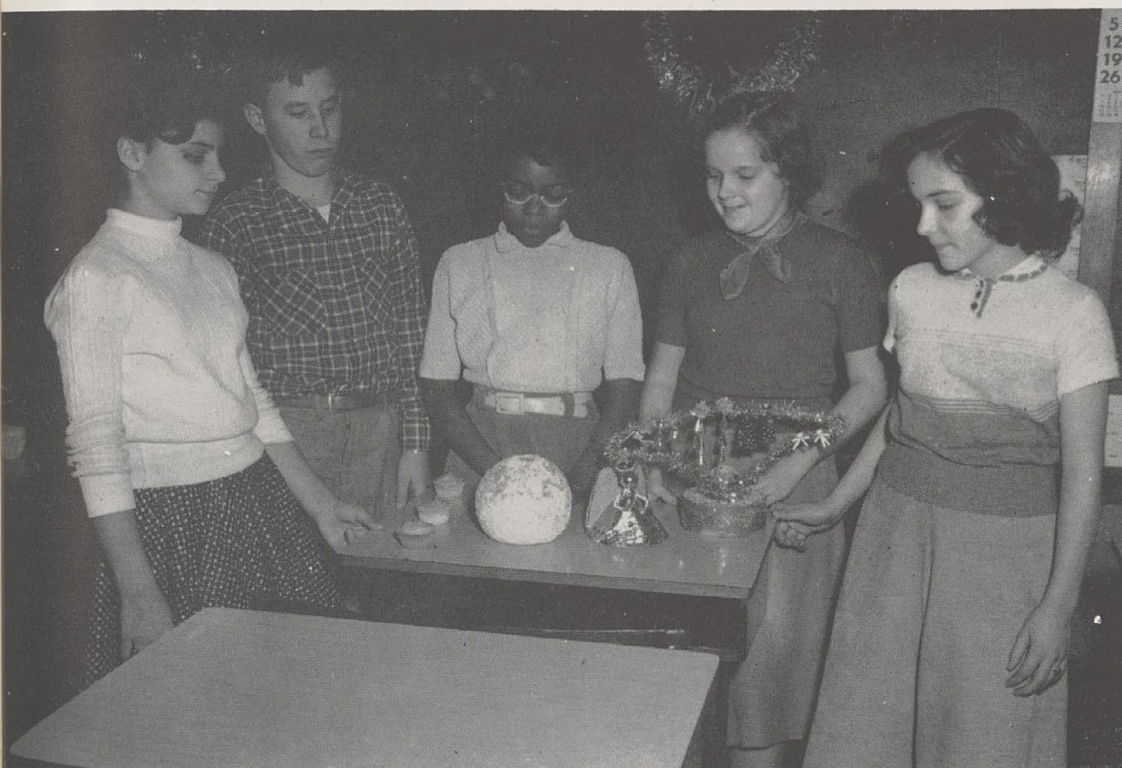
The Junior Science Club was started in December of 1953, the first year for the seventh and eighth-graders at Hughes.
