


Calvin Davis and Ray Eisen-
schmidt clear the hurdles.




Coach Paul Richert instructs,

Hughes "Cindermen" of 1956 have a good chance to win both the city and district championships, under the coaching skill of Paul Richert. Because of its early deadline, the Annual is unable to give results.

1955 saw the Big Reds finish first in the P.H.S.L. competition and also capture first place in the district meets. The team was then invited to participate in the P.H.S.L. Invitational Relay Meet, in which they again walked away with first place honors. The track men also took second place in the Withrow Relay. In state competition, Hughes finished seventeenth out of a total of forty-six teams. Bill Edwards finished second in the half-mile race in the state meet.

Seven lettermen return for Hughes this season. Leading the team are Bob Harrison, Calvin Davis, John Hochstrasser, Jim Carter, Hank Schwarz, Tom Bepler, and Clarence Rutland.

The junior "Cindermen" finished fifth in the city track meets last year. However, these younger track men show great promise for future years.
