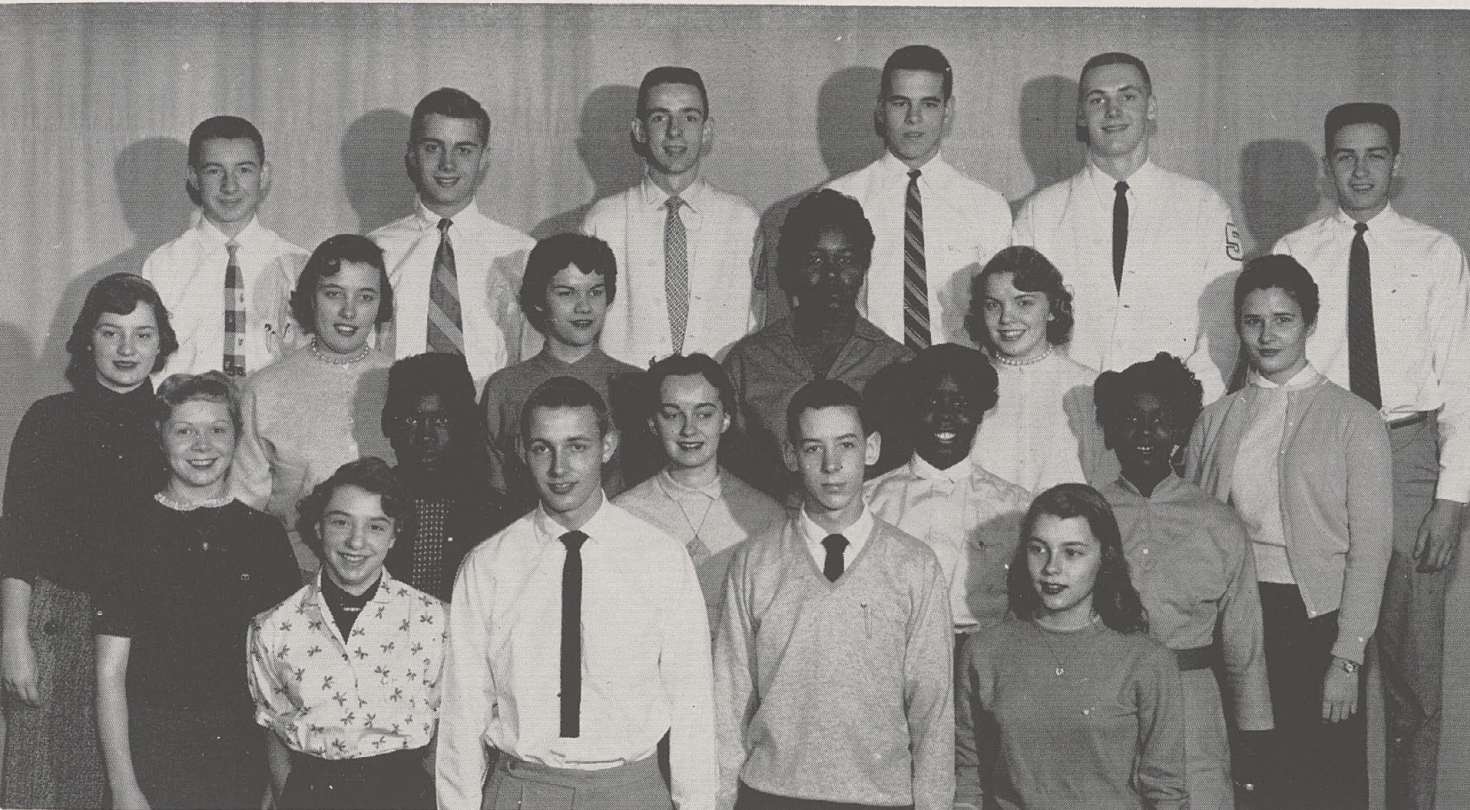


Council co-ordinates social club affairs
