

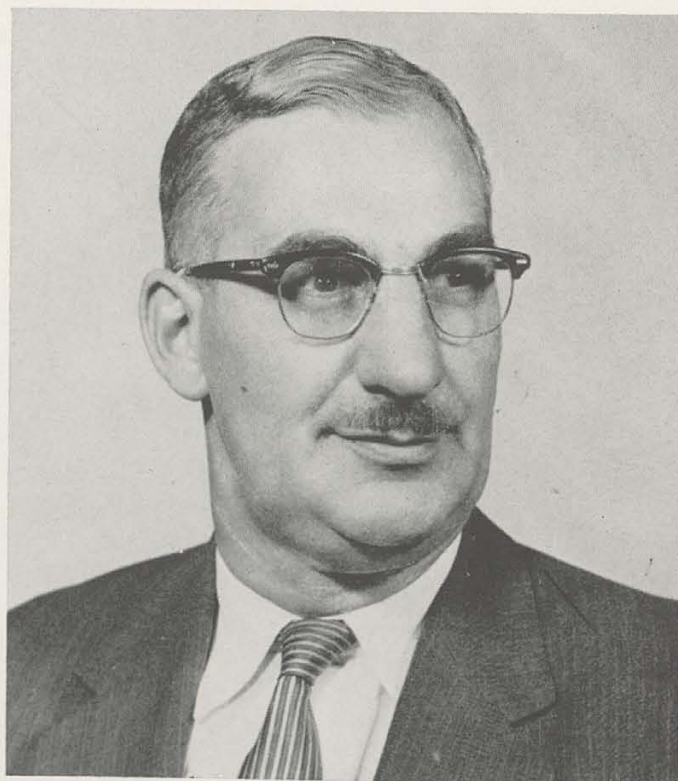
Track and Field
