COACH WILL HUNDEMER



The "Big Red" mermen, under their experienced coach, Will Hundemer, showed tremendous spirit this year. During the season, the varsity team twice defeated the Kentucky State "B" champs from Highland Heights. Howard Boorom finished third in the city diving contest, and traveled to Columbus for the state meet.

Mr. Hundemer has coached five of the National Olympic swimming champions, and the winner of the 1956 President's Cup for diving in previous years.

Next year the "Big Reds" will miss the talented services of senior swimmers Wes Welbourne, Rudy Muckenfuss, Jim Carter, Howard Boorom, Jay Severance, and Robert Reuss. Two outstanding juniors are Joe Compositor and Richard Zucker, while Ken Lockhard, Ron Schroeder, Jim West, and Cleon Wingard take honors for the junior high team. This year, the "Baby Reds" set a junior high record of 149.4 seconds for the two hundred yard free-style relay.

Coach Hundemer believed that the lack of depth was the most serious defect which hampered the success of the team.
