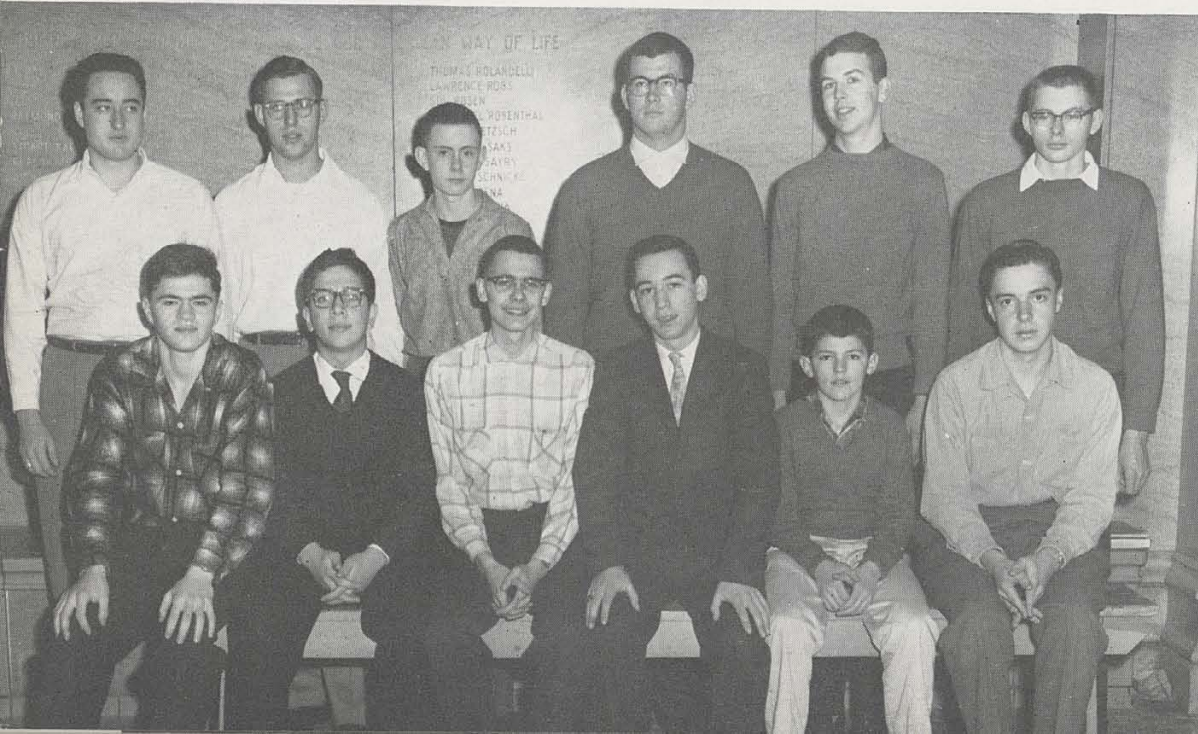


YOUTH FOR CHRIST
