The purpose of the club is to create a group for girls of high scholastic ability and the ambition for culture and knowledge. Zeta's motto is to uphold the name of Zeta Phi Epsilon to the very best of their ability and to help their sorority sisters understand the true meaning of "friendship" and "cooperation."

Delta Beta is the oldest fraternal group in Cincinnati, Ohio. The organization meeting was held on Thanksgiving Day, November 28, 1889. The fraternity was incorporated in 1902. The objectives of Delta Beta are to develop character, engender a fraternal spirit, to promote intelligence among its members and in general to exert a wholesome influence in school and community life. Its purposes are to promote benevolent, charitable and social aspects; to encourage hospitality and friendship; culture and social improvement.

There are, at present, five chapters of Delta Beta. They are at Hughes, Walnut Hills, Wyoming, Country Day and Woodward. There are plans of expansion under construction. Social activities include date parties, picnics and dances. The club goes caroling with Interfraternity Council at Christmas and helps the Heart Fund by working with the "Hart Mart."
