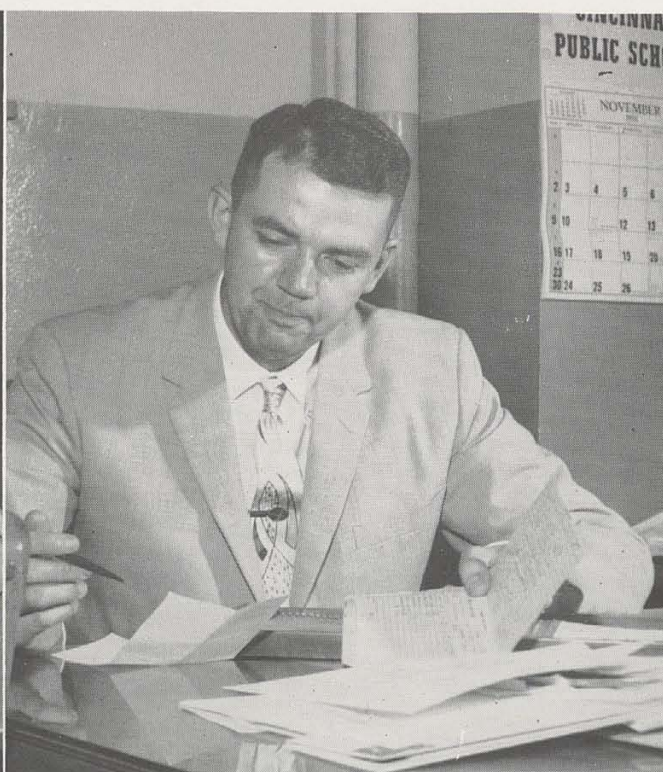


# Junior High Counselors Advise Hughestown Citizens
