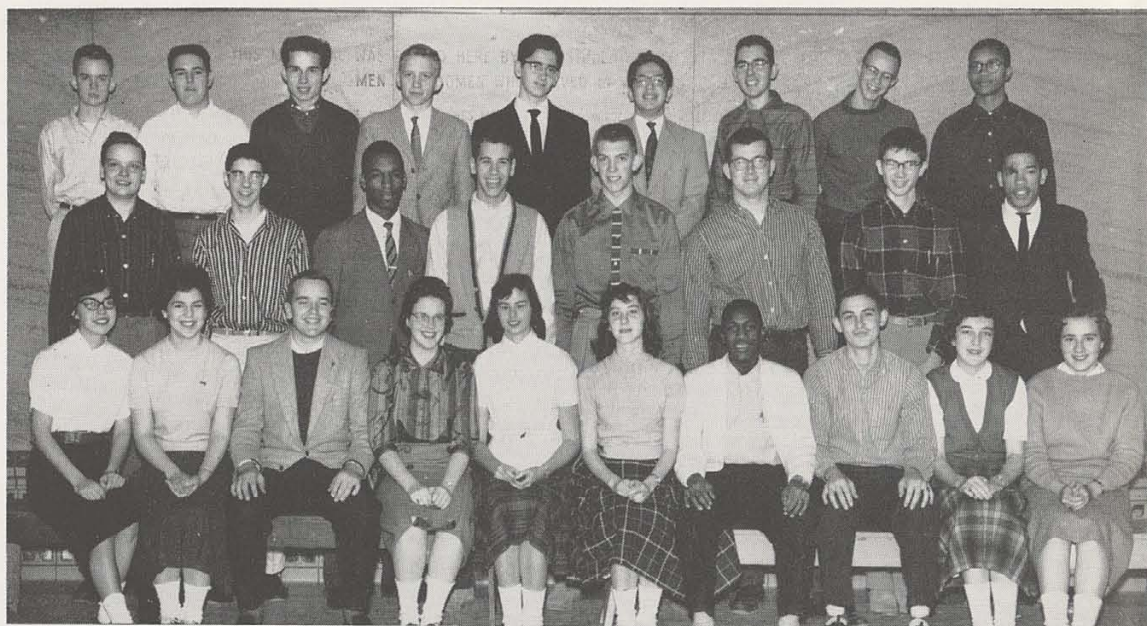

## Math Club

Math Club, founded at Hughes in 1920 by Mr. Reeves, a math teacher at the time, was reorganized this year, after a year of no Math Club. The purpose of this club is to discuss subjects in Math of general interest to all student members. Membership is limited to students who have had Math III or IV or students who have had Math III and have a written recommendation from their teacher. The members meet the second Thursday of each month to hear guest speakers from

the faculty of the University of Cincinnati, to hear student speakers, to watch a demonstration of business machines, to make cartoons with compasses, or to take part in an equation scavenger hunt ending in a picnic. Math Club existed not for itself alone. The club gave all the proceeds of a bake sale to the Christmas Fund and gave the remainder of its dues to help the school buy a computer.
