One hundred mellow voices gently ring out through the halls of Hughes every day third bell. These are the voices of Senior Choir members practicing their songs for the many concerts they present during the year. The choir is directed by Mr. Bige Hammons, who is a graduate of the Cincinnati College-Conservatory of Music.

Senior Choir is composed of boys and girls from the tenth, eleventh, and twelfth grades. All students who wish to join the group must audition for Mr. Hammons and must be familiar with music.

During the year, the choir performs at the Christmas concert and assembly, the spring concert, Easter assembly, Merry-Go-Round, and graduation. It also gives programs for organizations outside of school.

This year, instead of rehearsing at 7:30 A. M., the Ensemble meets separately from choir. This selected group consists of twenty-four students chosen from Senior Choir. They perform with the choir and give additional concerts as well. Every year their big event is singing on WKRC-TV at Christmas time.

The choir has several annual social events during the year. Its biggest celebration is the Senior Choir banquet in the fall. On this occasion, the officers and new members are initiated. The students end the banquet with the traditional candle-lighting ceremony and singing of the Benediction. The choir always ends the year with a big picnic at Winton Woods before saying farewell for the summer.
