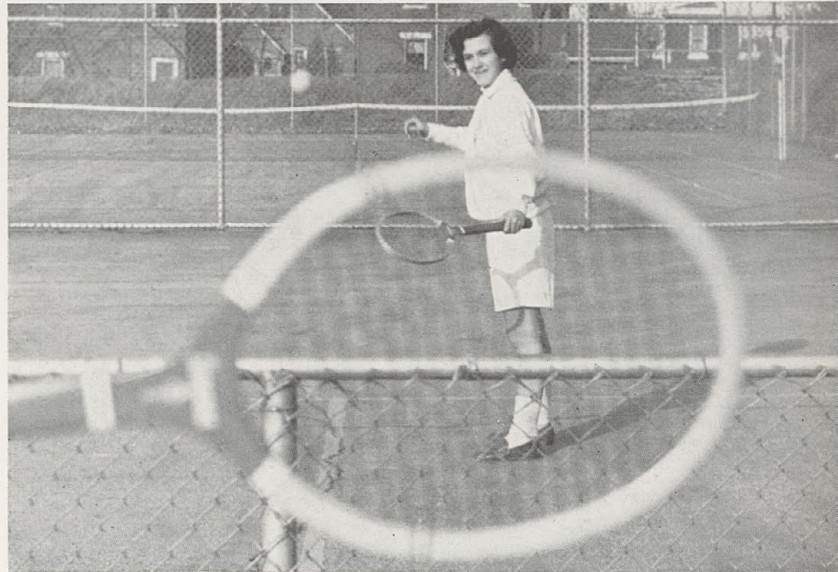


## Tennis

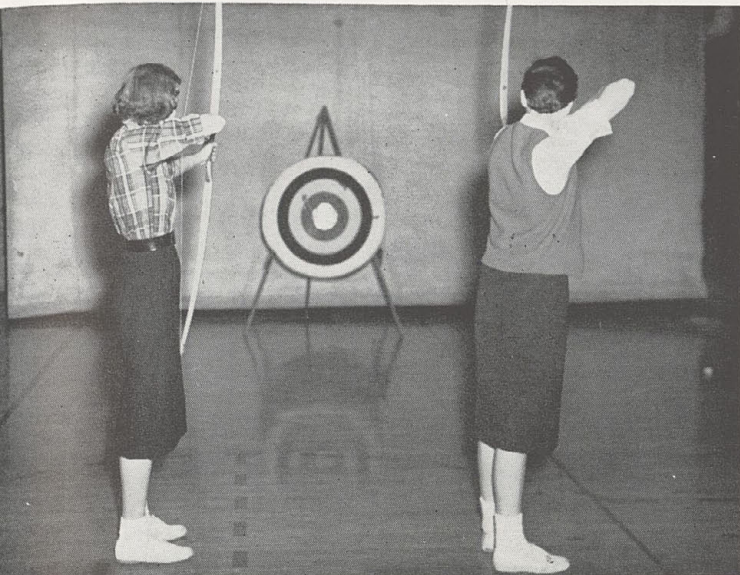
Paula Neumann
