Last season the cindermen had to cope with the power of a Taft team, which ranked among the top teams of the state. Hughes was forced to take a back seat to the Senators in every meet in which both teams participated. The Knights of Columbus Meet gave the Hughes team its first chance to display its power. In the PHSL Invitational Meet Hughes took second place as in the K. of C. Meet, scoring 40 points to Taft's 70. Withrow then put on a display of power and overtook Hughes in the PHSL Championship Meet.

The Hughes track team has a tradition behind it of six championships in the last 24 years. Individual athletes have set fifteen track records in the same period of time.
