Fifth Place Finish for Varsity Harriers; Second, for Reserves

Hughes cross-country runners made an acceptable showing in Public High School League competition by finishing in fifth place. The Big Red harriers, coached by Mr. Rolfes, came behind Walnut Hills in fourth place, Woodward in third, Withrow in second and Courter Technical, league champions.

The Hughes team, second in the first P.H.S.L. meet, collected 117 points. In the second and third meets, the Big Reds slipped to fifth place, with 111 and 92 points, respectively. They ended league competition with a total of

320 points. Aiken, Taft and Western Hills trailed Hughes.

In district competition, Hughes came in ninth out of twenty-one teams. Greg Ross, lead runner for Hughes, Dwight Quarles, Paul Chapman, Captain Don Wagner, and John King were the top runners for Varsity.
