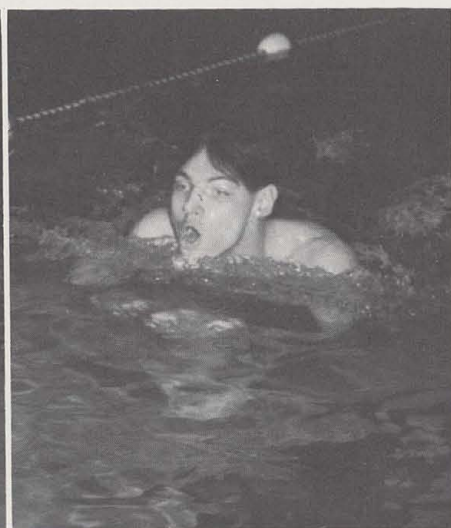


Bottom Row: Danny Huber, Joe Mechley, Howard Marsh, Art Dixon.

## Strahler's Swimmers Few in Number but a Happy Crew

A small squad of varsity swimmers, the Big Reds displayed plenty of courage and determination in participating in tough League competition. The mermen got off to a slow start in several dual and quadrangular meets. Then, in the first Public High School League meet, Terry Mueller placed seventh in the 100-yard breast stroke, Don Huber came in ninth in the 100-yard butterfly, and Joe Mechley finished twelfth in the 400-yard free-style. These swimmers finished in the same positions in the second League meet.

In the final meet, Dan Huber repeated his ninth-place finish in the 100-yard butterfly but Terry Mueller and Joe Mechley each edged up one position in their respective events. These three mermen acquired a total of sixty-five points for the Big Reds. Wayne Snoddy, Bill Oehler, Howard Marsh and Art Dixon helped form various relay teams, which accumulated forty-four points.
