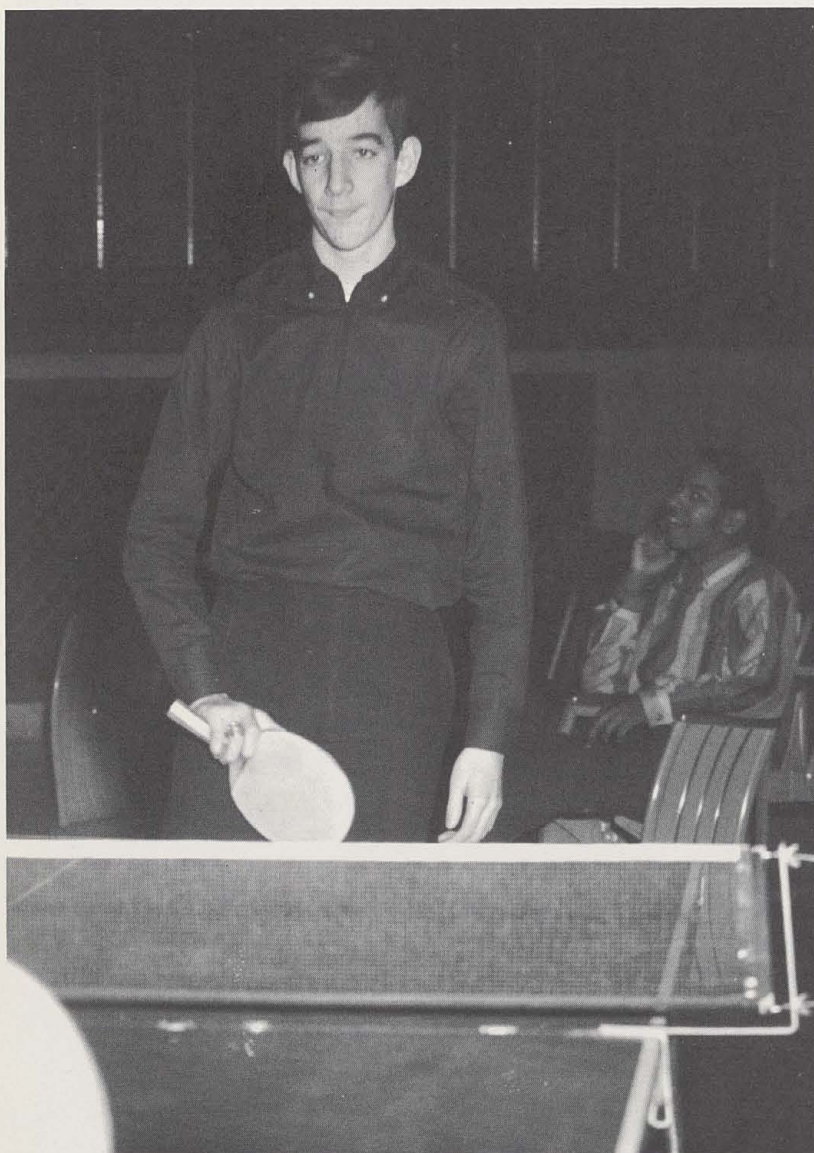
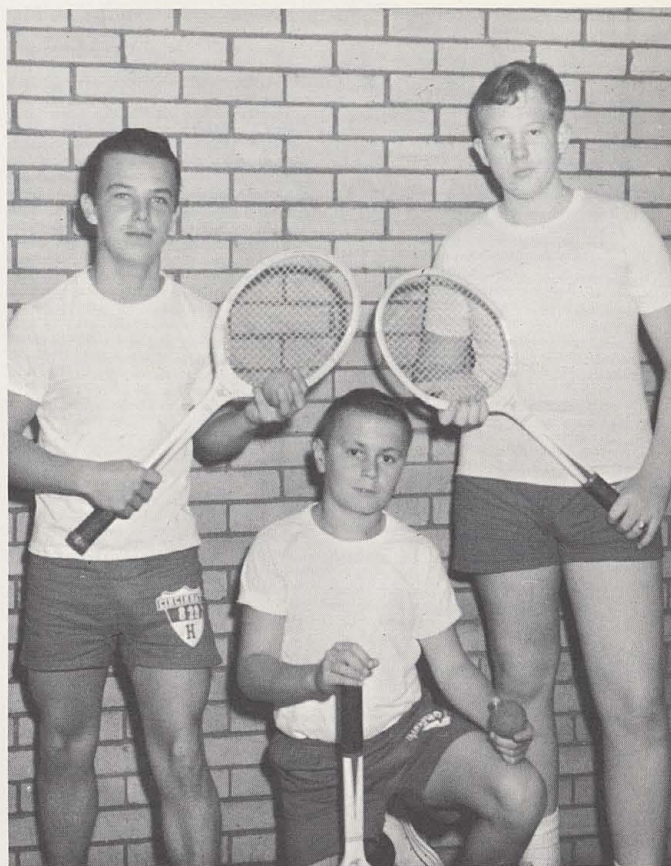




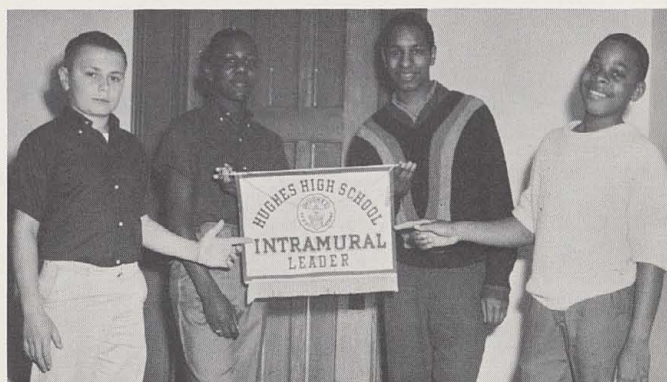
Plenty of muscles get built up in the weight-lifting program.

To provide healthy exercise and entertainment for all students, the intramural program at Hughes now includes twenty-two events conducted throughout the year.
