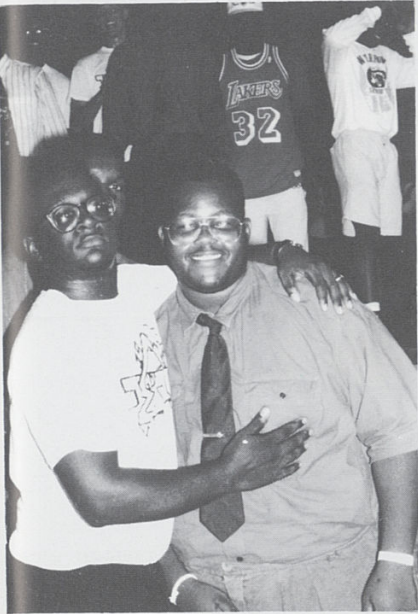
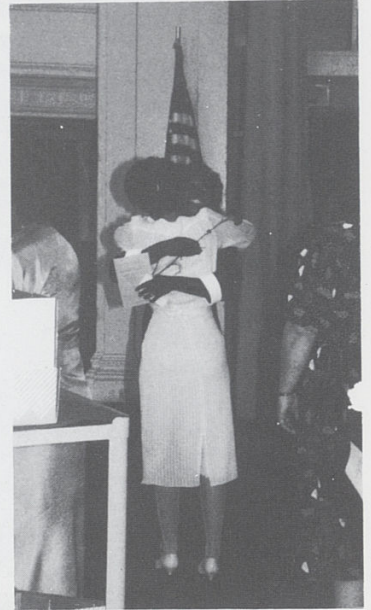


SENIOR CLASS DAY
