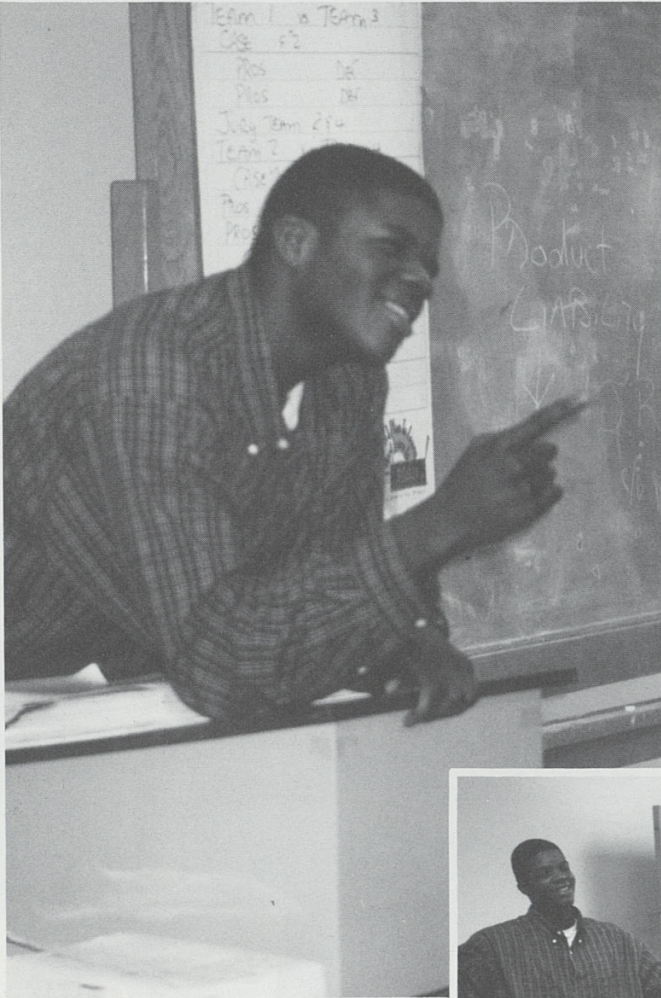


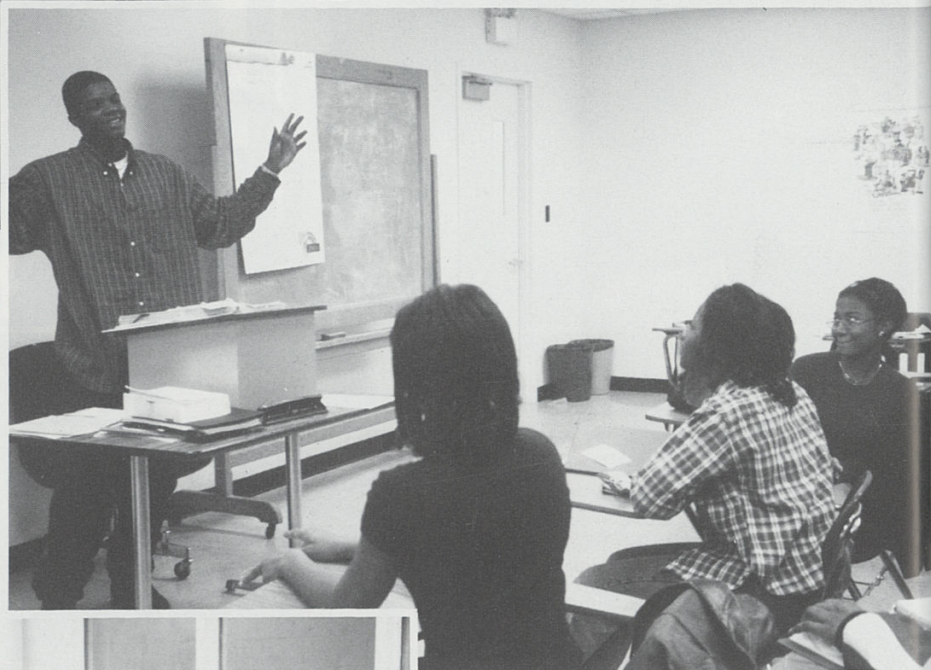
Career Paths
