

# International Baccalaureate

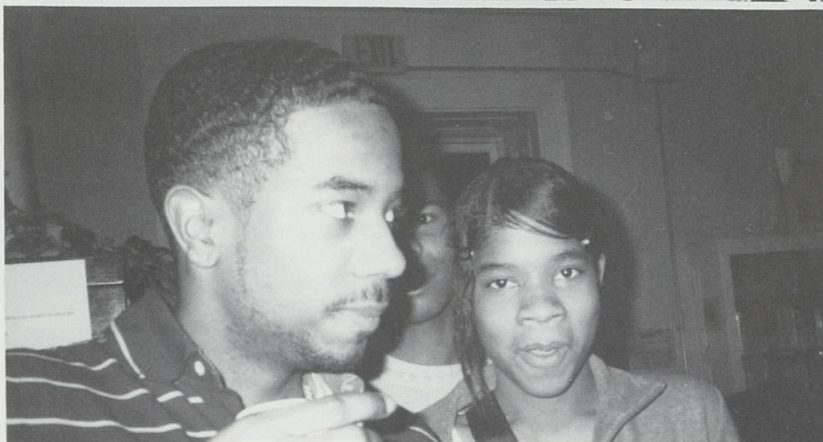
