The **F** in **F**reedom stands for **F**ree

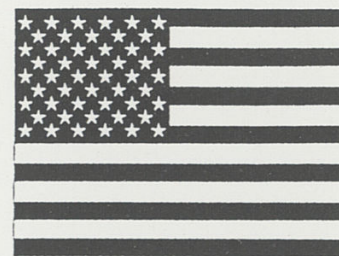
The **R** for **R**ebel
