We had some wonderful assemblies this year. It made us especially proud when we participated in them.

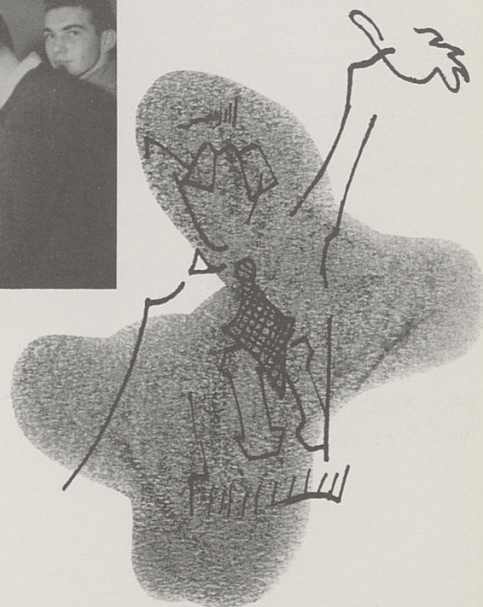
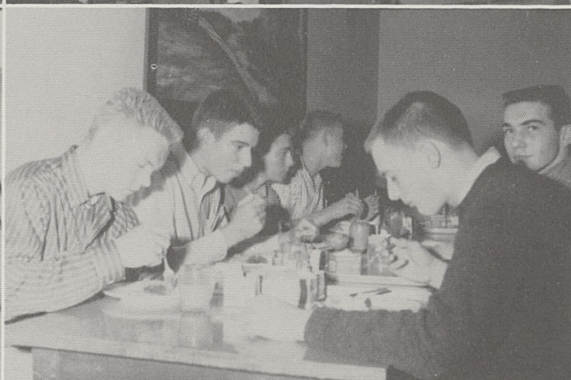
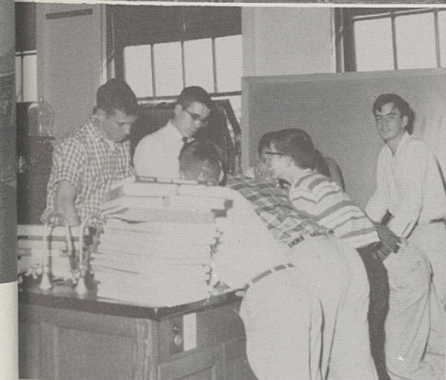
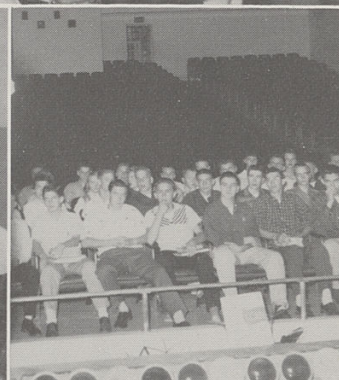
Those lunch periods were so much fun! That is when we really got the chance to meet new faces. We remember some of the things we discussed over that good cafeteria food.
