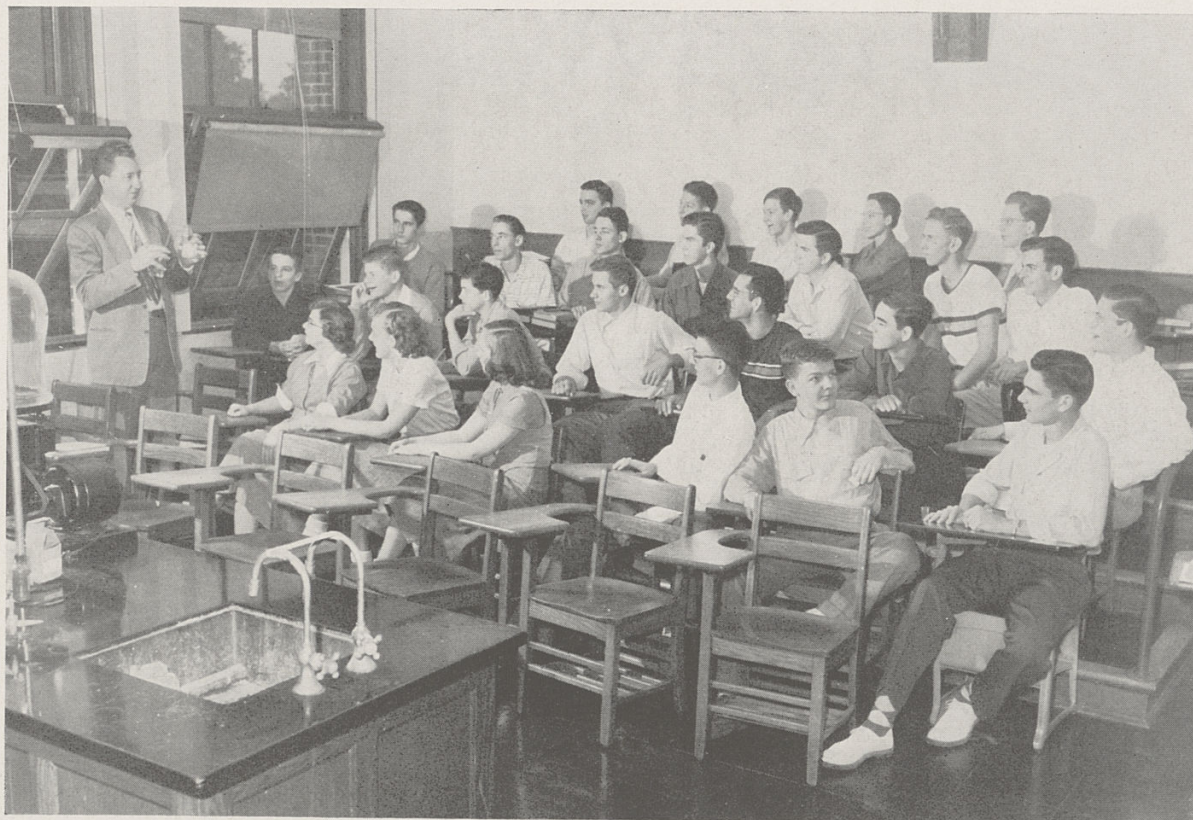


THE SCIENCE CLUB
