The 1954 track team showed up quite well for a team consisting of almost all juniors and sophomores. Fred Mansell was the only loss to the 1955 team.

Mr. Kusel's thinclads placed seventh in the fifteenth Annual Mariemont Invitational, sixth in the Lockland Night Relays, and seventh in Senior Division of the M.V.I.L. They won the three other divisions by scoring eighty points to the second place total

of thirty-eight. This was the highest number of points ever scored in a Jr. Division.
