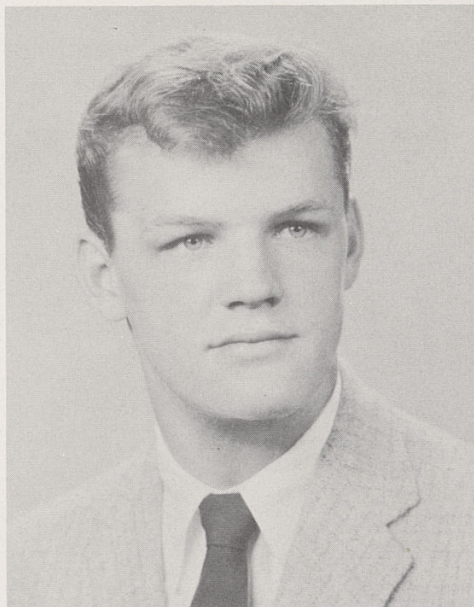


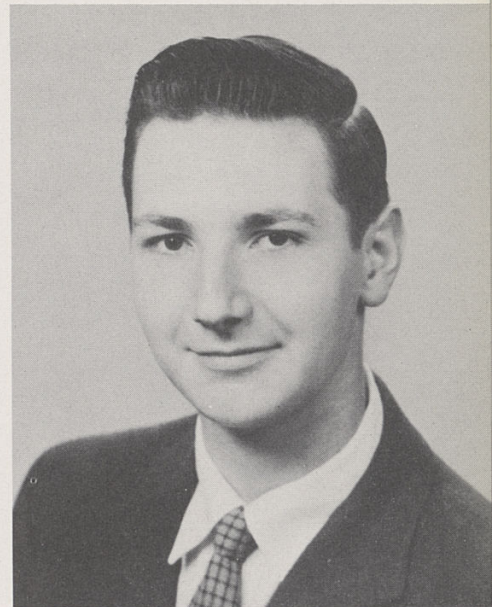
WILLIAM HENRY NECKEL
