# LIBRARY STAFF

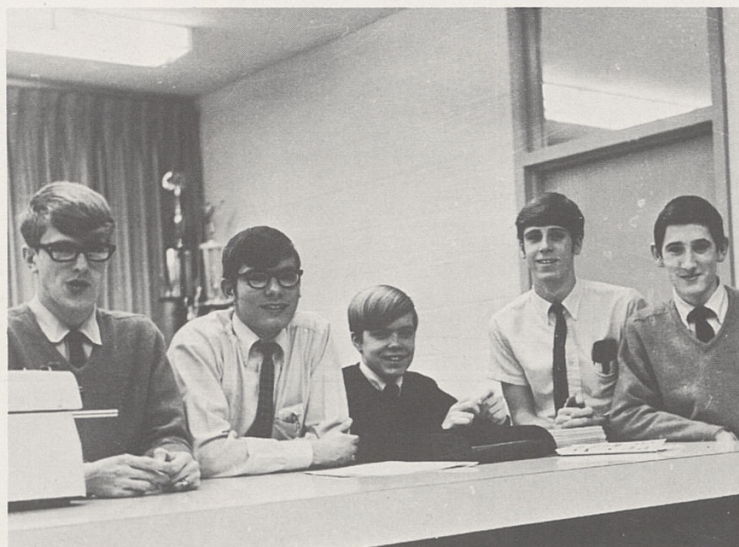
