Suspect: "We were only lagging pennies."

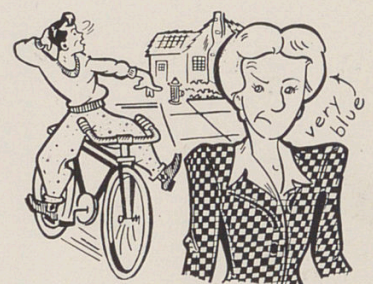
Mrs. Hartsell: "Well, of all things! Who is the teacher in charge here?"
