



MISS GRACE ANSHUTZ teaches English I, II, and III. She enjoys traveling and is interested in the theater.



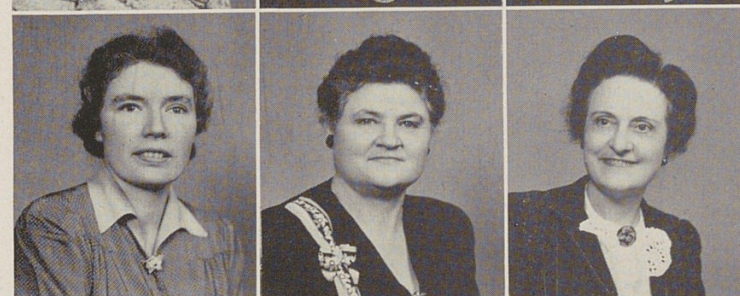

Social Studies teacher at Junior High is MISS RUTH COE, who likes the movies, sports, (especially baseball) and traveling.



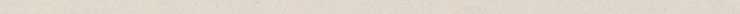
When midyear rolls around you'll find MISS MAY CONNER, math teacher, sponsoring a senior math club called, The Pythagareon.



Teaching art all day doesn't tire MISS LOUISA COOK. In her spare time she is found doing landscape painting and likes studying bird life.



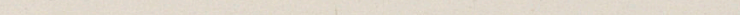
MISS EFFIE CORCORAN is a teacher of typing, shorthand, and secretarial practice. She also is a great help to the Annual Staff.
