MISS CATHERINE MOLIQUE is a new teacher in the Mathematics Department and co-sponsor of Alpha-Y.

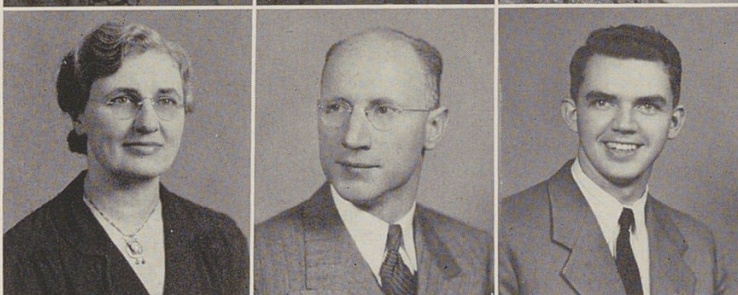
Being a sponsor of Scribblers takes much of MISS HILDA MOORMAN'S spare time. She teaches English and enjoys poetry, travel, and the theater.

MRS. SYLVIA NIKOLOFF teaches German and spends her spare time as sponsor of the German Club.

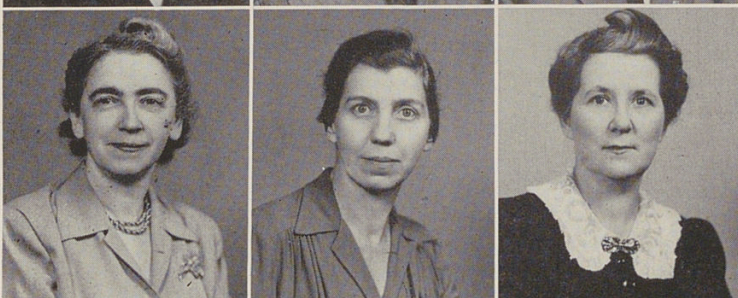
Besides teaching gym and swimming, MR. LOMOND NIMMO takes charge of the track teams and the football line. He also enjoys good music.
