Led by Bob Hill and Leon Macklin in the hurdle events, Charlie Moore in the 100 and 200 yard dashes, Lucky Ingram and Bill Gray in the 440, Bill Drier in the half mile, Dick Miller in the high jump and broad jump, Bob Economou and Don Rogers in the discus throw, and Rogers in the shot put, the Tigers roared through their first meets with but one defeat and then took the first annual Withrow Relays. (Results are through April 27). The junior track team whose chief point getters were Zornes, Russell, Davis, Fey, and Donahue did well, winning the PHSL junior title.
