

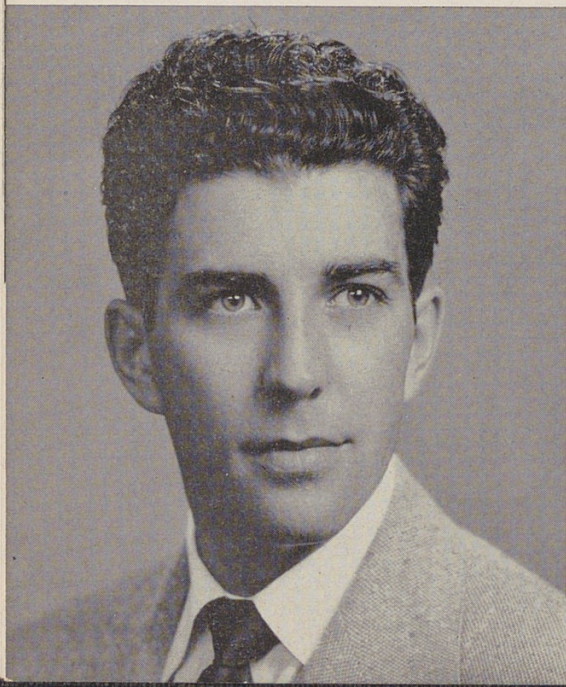


Mrs. Stella Green Kreuzman
