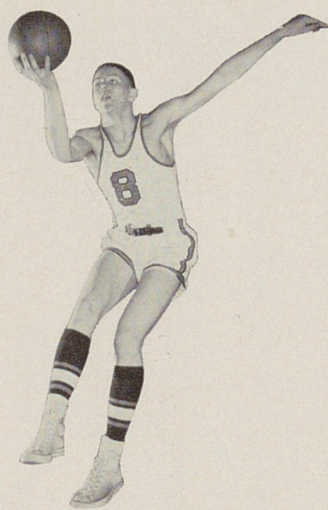
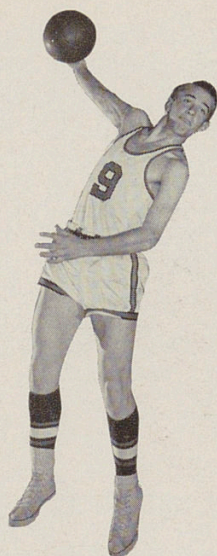


DON McDANIEL F 5-10 160
