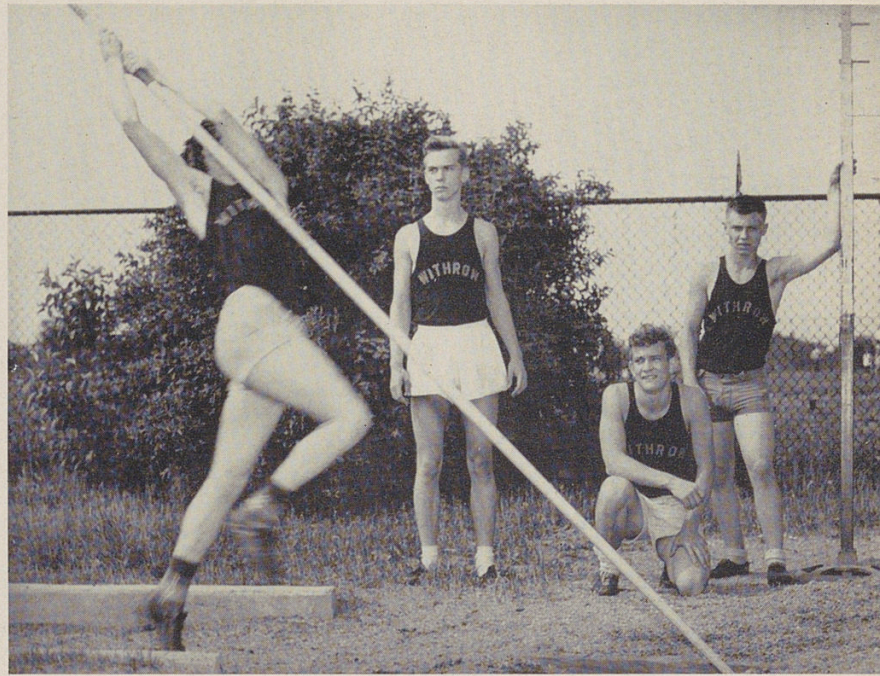


Davis gathers speed and starts his ascent over the pole vault while Armstrong, Manning and Wright watch his style and grace.
