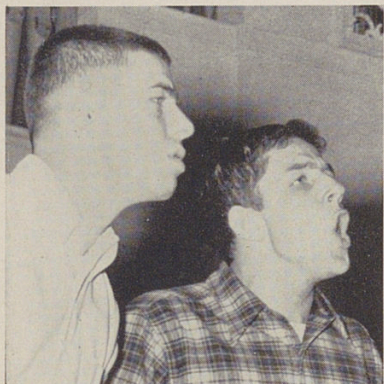


Minstrel Tryouts
