

Career Paths

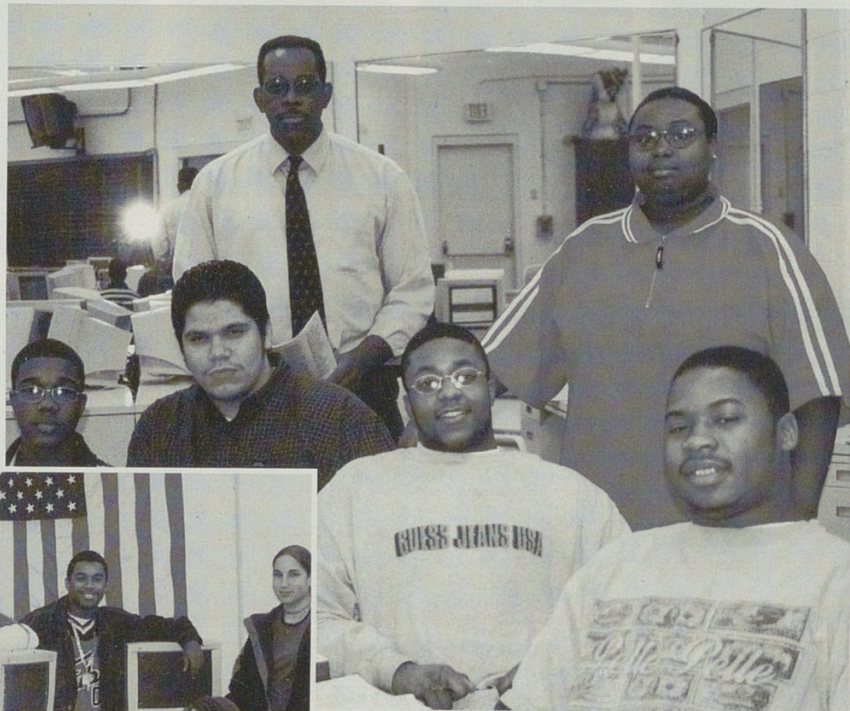
