

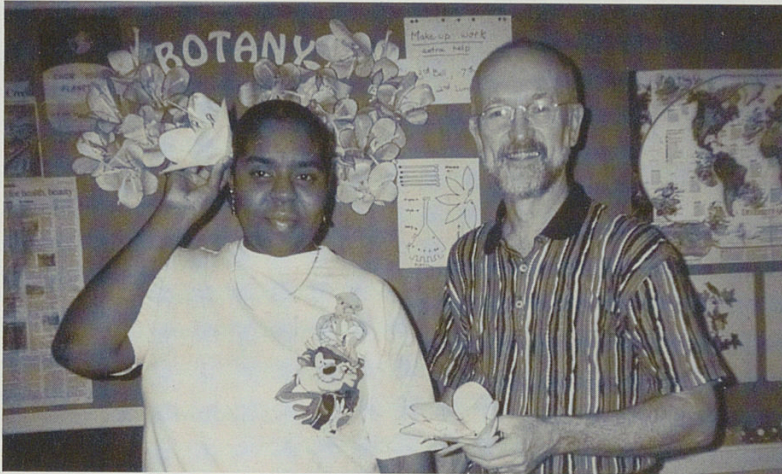


International Studies Academy

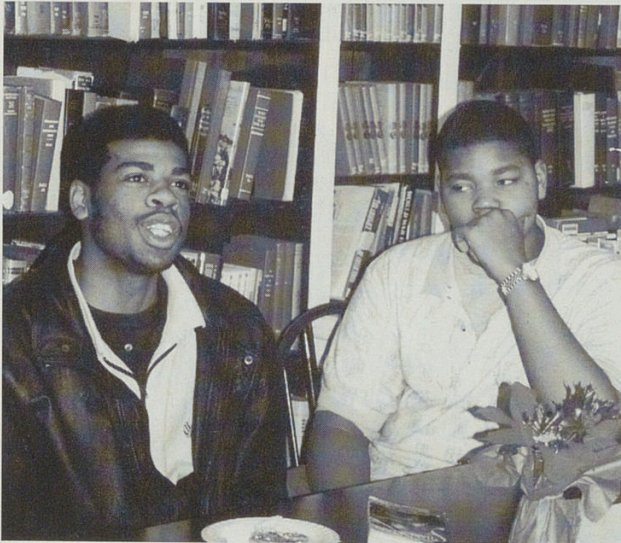
A CPS Magnet High School for Foreign Languages and an International Baccalaureate World School

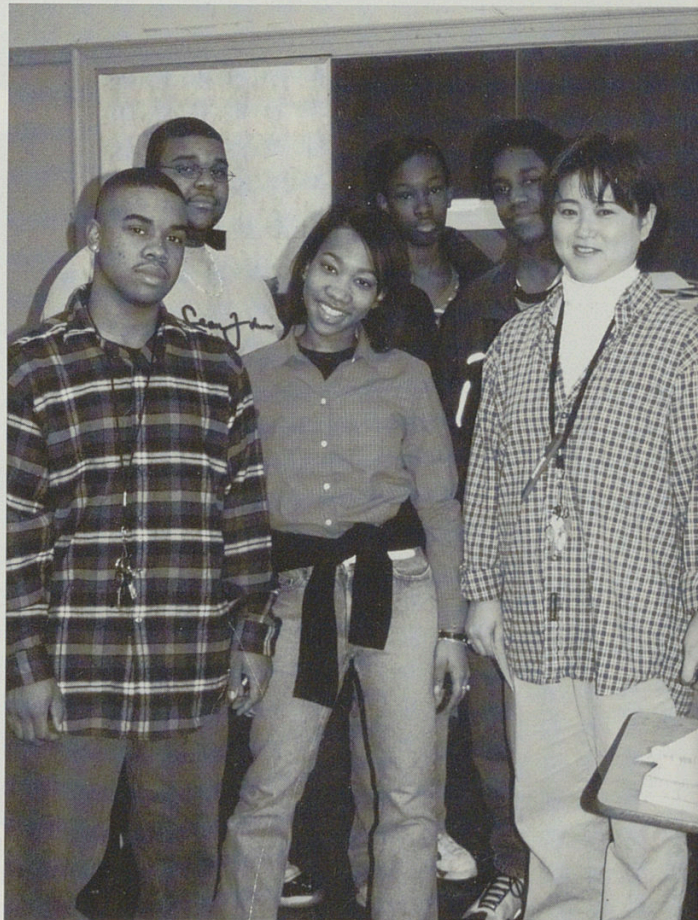
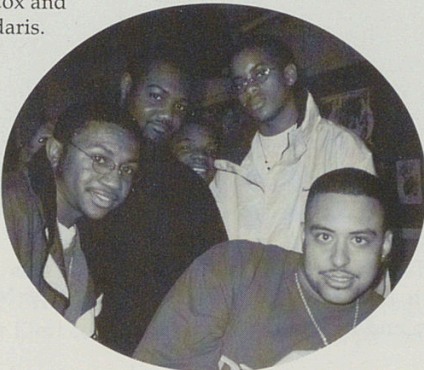
