Doctor Leon Denning Peaslee died on April 8, 1950. He had served at Woodward as both teacher and principal, the latter assignment extending over the period from 1940-1950. To those teachers and pupils who knew and worked with Doctor Peaslee, his death comes as a severe blow. His place will not be lightly filled nor easily taken.
