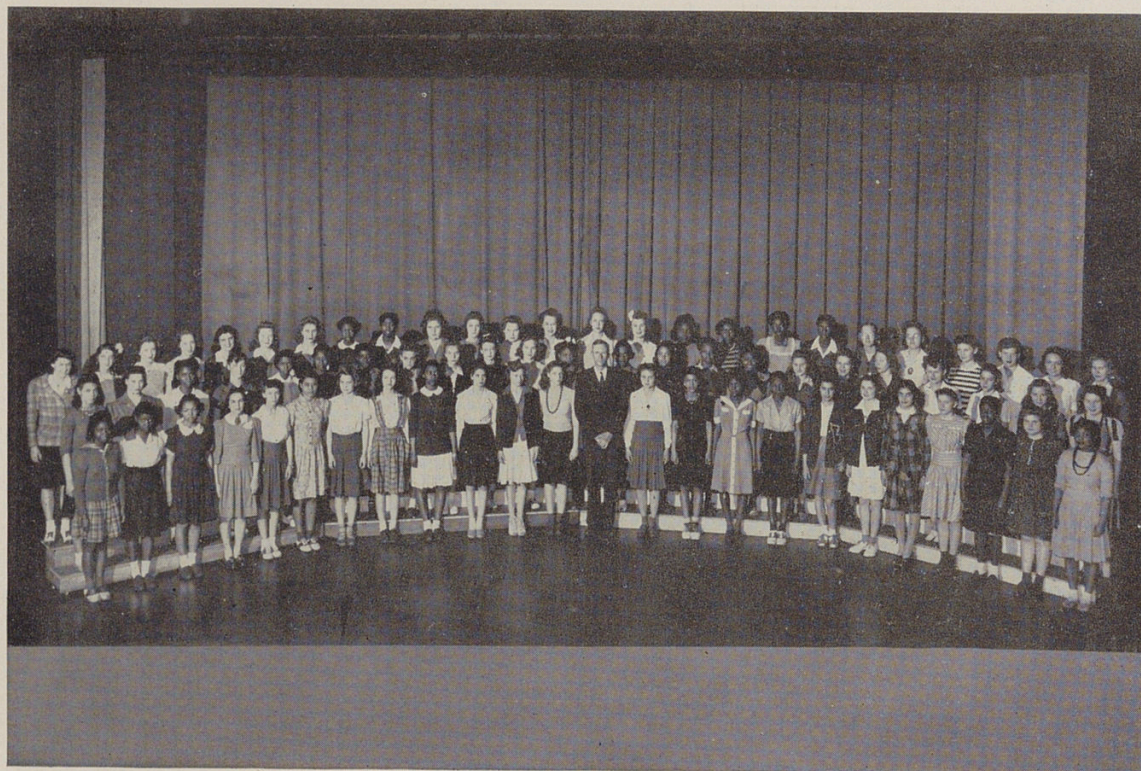


MUSIC
