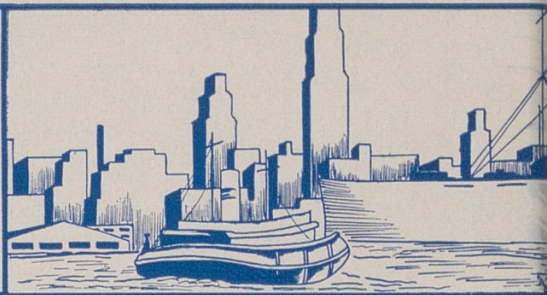




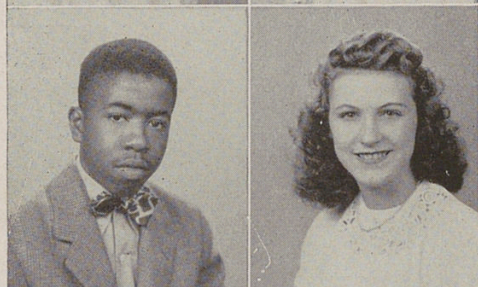
# Seniors

SIMALTON, MELVIN

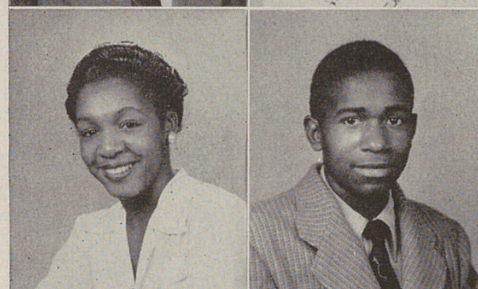
Old Woodward Theta Club, Hi-Y.

"A sharp dresser. Doesn't give the girls a break. Studies hard and draws dividends. A good friend, and well liked."



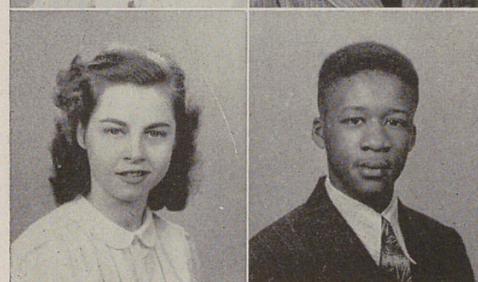
SMITH, ALBERT

SMITH, JEAN

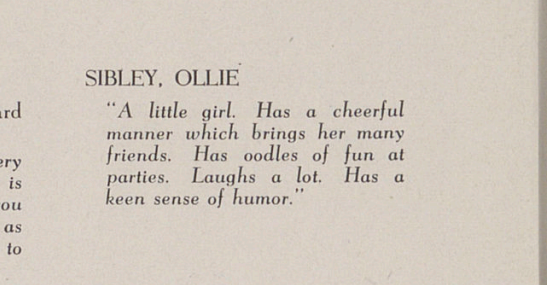
"Her quietness hides her winning personality. She usually has very little to say, but has many friends. Liked by everyone who knows her."



SMITH, MARILYN

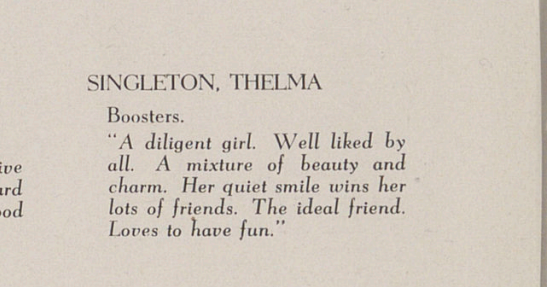

SIBLEY, OLLIE

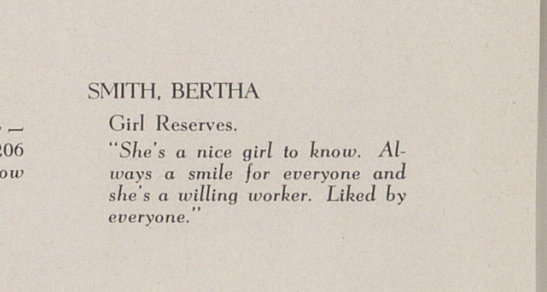
"A little girl. Has a cheerful manner which brings her many friends. Has oodles of fun at parties. Laughs a lot. Has a keen sense of humor."

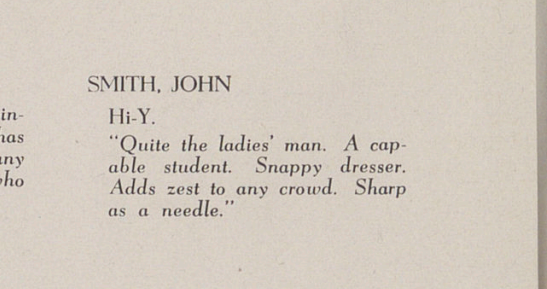
"A diligent girl. Well liked by all. A mixture of beauty and charm. Her quiet smile wins her lots of friends. The ideal friend. Loves to have fun."

Girl Reserves.

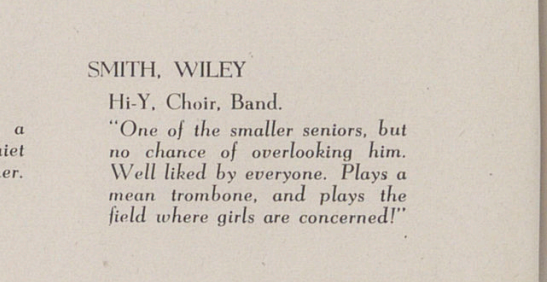
"She's a nice girl to know. Always a smile for everyone and she's a willing worker. Liked by everyone."
