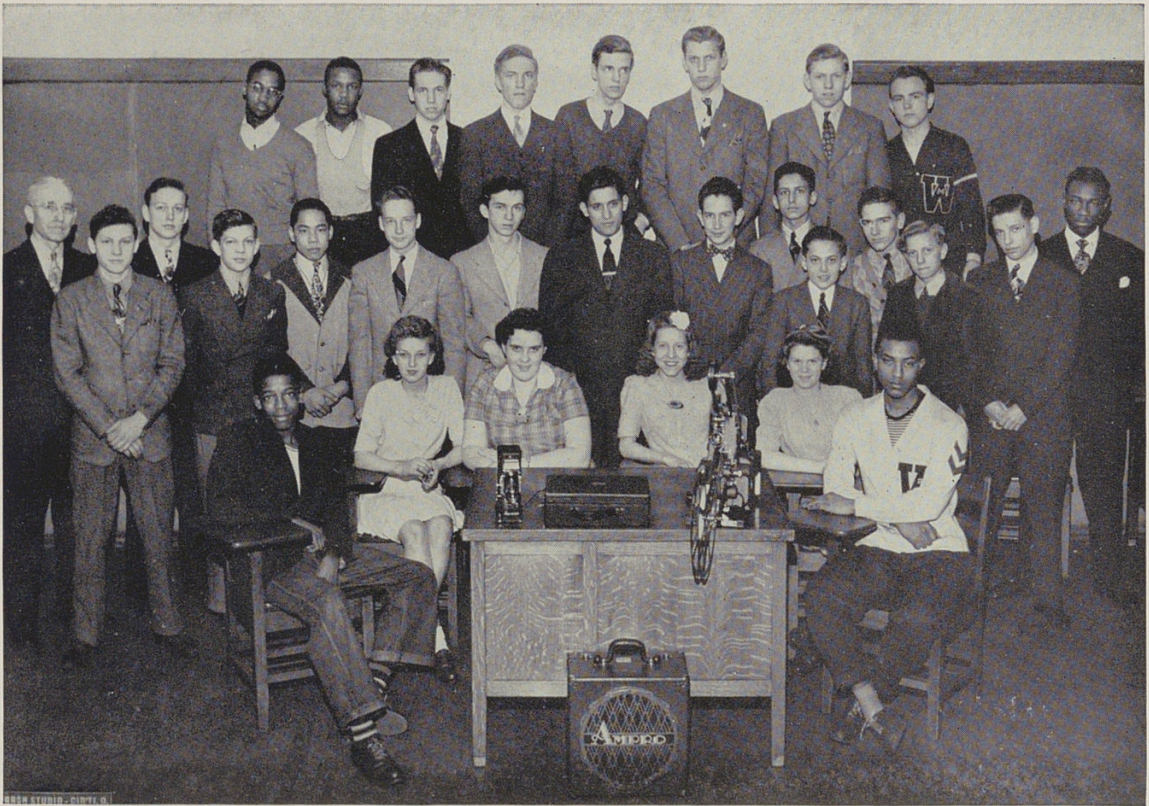


# Visual Aids
