The Vocational Foods Class was begun at Woodward High School three years ago to train students for employment in commercial eating places. There is an increasing number of such opportunities for part-time work. Large quantity cooking is taught in the Home Economics laboratory in cooperation with the Woodward Lunchroom. Each student spends about one third of the time in the Lunchroom to become familiar with large quantity equipment, selling techniques, and the handling of money.
