

The Student Council of Woodward High School is composed of forty students, ten representing each grade. The members are nominated by petition and are elected by the grade which they represent. The qualifications for membership include satisfactory grades, good citizenship, and willingness to serve.

The Student Council serves Woodward in every way possible. It conducts clothing drives, sends representatives to meetings which Woodward has been invited to attend, and makes collections in the homerooms, such as those for the War Memorial Fund. The Council undertakes any task assigned to it by the school administration.

The executive committee is composed of thirteen members elected by the Council from its own members. This committee conducts such business as needs immediate attention between the regular monthly meetings of the Council.
