"We were happy when he returned from the Army. A handsome bachelor in our midst! We were broken-hearted when he took unto himself a wife!"

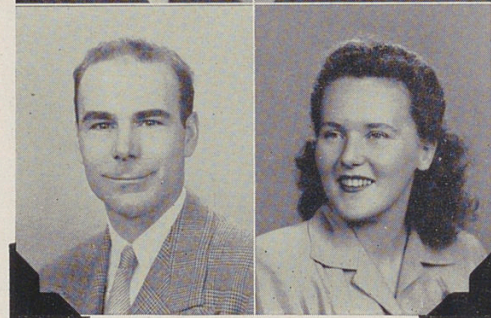


MR. EDWARD A. ESHMAN
