MISS JULIA W. JOHNSTON

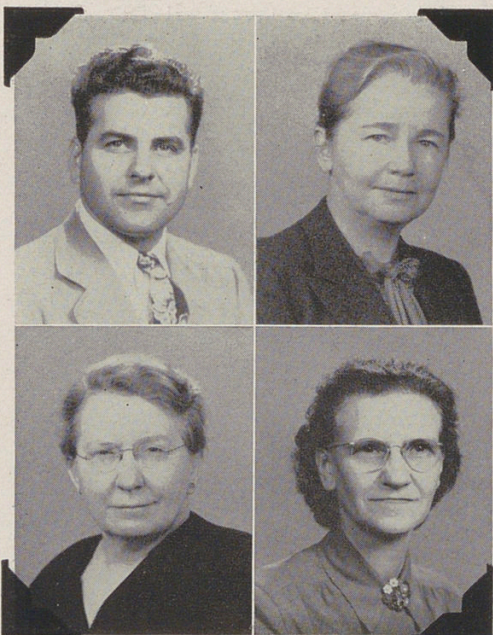
"Teaches History and a thorough job she does of it. Always succeeds in getting her ideas and ideals across."
